Course Details

Here is what you can estimate to pay for the entry level, Open Water SCUBA Diver course.*

-Books and the materials you need to get started.....\$99.00 (Paid when books are picked up)

-Class and pool days with an experienced, certified and insured scuba instructor, pool rental, rental gear for pool.....\$387.00 Paid no less than one week before class

Florida dive and instructor fees for both days.....\$402.00 (Total paid represents bools, rentals, entrance fees, boat fees, 2 air refills and all taxes. (Paid no less than two week before class, serves as boat deposit, when applicable)

Does not include: Wet suit of appropriate thickness for day 1, paid directly to dive site \$15/day
